Fayette County Project Enrich Supported Parenting Classes are held each Wednesday at the Fayette County Department of Human and Children's Services and funded by a Tennessee Child Abuse Prevention Grant. The class is held Wednesdays from 12:00-1:30pm. The program is tailored for any parent or expectant parent who is interested in learning new and effective parenting skills. Snacks are provided; transportation is an option. Our Family Support Specialist will also conduct home-visits with those parents who qualify. The program utilizes Dr. Stephen Bavolek's evidence based "Nurturing Parenting" curriculum and consists of 12 sessions ranging in topics from Development to Safety to Rules and Discipline. Each parent is given a pre and post assessment to provide insight into the parent's progress. We strive to provide all parents with access to effective parenting skills useful for raising healthy children.
