



## Hospital Overview

The University of Tennessee College of Medicine - Chattanooga Pediatrics Residency Program is based at Children's Hospital at Erlanger:

- **Continuously ACGME-accredited since 1966**
- 130-bed regional tertiary care facility, including 46 acute care beds
- 18-bed PICU
- 65-bed NICU
- Region's only pediatric teaching hospital
- State of the Art Pediatric Outpatient Center opened December 2018
- 1 of 4 Comprehensive Regional Pediatric Centers in Tennessee
- More than 40,000 annual patient visits in Emergency Room, staffed 24/7 by board-certified pediatric emergency medicine physicians

## Program Overview

- 10 residents per level
- Offer innovative 3+1 rotation scheduling, allowing for focused educational experience
- Board review Mon AM, Ambulatory Lecture Tues AM, Grand Rounds Wed AM, Morning Report Thurs AM, 3-hour Fri PM Lecture block
- 50% of graduates go on to fellowships, 40% enter private practice, 10% become hospitalists
- Built-in time for independent study, scholarly activity, community service and advocacy
- Active resident wellness program
- Supportive Faculty Mentorship program

## Faculty

- Close working relationship between faculty and residents is the foundation of our program
- 70 full-time faculty (36 male, 34 female) and 8 part-time faculty
- 65+ volunteer faculty who practice general pediatrics and related subspecialties in the community
